Treat others well, and stand up for what is right.

Habit of Character	I show respect.
What Does It Mean	This means I appreciate the abilities, qualities and achievements of others, and treat myself, others, and the environment with care.
What Does It Look Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applauding others when they have done well • Taking care around the classroom not to break things or hurt people • Returning borrowed items in the same condition you were given them • Throwing trash in the trash can • Recycling
What Does It Sound Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “I really appreciate . . . because . . .” • “You did a great job with . . . because . . .”
Habit of Character	I behave with integrity.
What Does It Mean	This means I am honest and do the right thing, even when it’s difficult, because it is the right thing to do.
What Does It Look Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admitting when at fault • Doing homework • Keeping eyes on own work
What Does It Sound Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “I’m sorry, but I . . .”
Habit of Character	I show empathy.
What Does It Mean	This means I understand and I share or take into account the feelings, situation, or attitude of others.
What Does It Look Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listening carefully and showing the appropriate facial expression for the situation
What Does It Sound Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “I understand how you feel.” • “I can imagine how you feel.”

Habit of Character	I show compassion.
What Does It Mean	This means I notice when others are sad or upset and try to help them.
What Does It Look Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Approaching a friend or classmate who looks upset
What Does It Sound Like?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• “You look upset, is everything OK? Is there anything I can do to help?”
