Firsthand account	Based on personal experience	Uses pronouns like I, me, we Examples from text: <i>We were terribly harassed. There were always men and women standing out there harassing us and throwing some pretty bad insults.</i>
Secondhand account	Based on research	Uses pronouns like he, she, and they Examples from text: <i>They started off standing silently, holding picket signs reading, “Mr. President, what will you do for Woman Suffrage?” and “How Long Must Women Wait for Liberty?”</i>
