

Let's Review

Rounding - To find a number that is close to a given number.





Let's Review

Rounding can occur in multiple places within a number.

$$34,789 = 34,800$$

 $34,789 = 35,000$
 $34,789 = 30,000$



A Common Mistake

Always rounding to the leading digit.

For Example:
How many pencils will the school need to purchase if there are 1,230 students?

1 box of pencils = 100





On Saturday, <u>47</u>893 people visited the aquarium. About how many people visited the aquarium?

About 68,000 visited the aquarium.





Liberty Elementary needs to purchase water bottles for field day. If 1,529 students attend Liberty Elementary, about how many water bottles should be purchased if the water comes in cases of 100?






1,529 students = 1,600 water bottles





My family went on a long trip! On Monday, we drove 257 miles, on Juesday we drove 312 miles, and on Wednesday we drove 145 miles. About how many miles did we drive in all?
