What is the frog?	What is the adaptation?	How does this help the frog survive?
poison dart frog	<i>toxic skin</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>paralyzes and kills predators that touch it</i> • <i>poison comes from the food the frog eats</i> • <i>poison builds up in its body as it eats the food</i>
poison dart frog	<i>brightly colored</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>red, yellow</i> • <i>colors warn others that it is poisonous</i>
poison dart frog	<i>female moves eggs after they hatch</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>lays eggs on a leaf to hide them from predators</i> • <i>moves them to a water-filled location when they hatch</i>
